1. Experience Requirements

The Supplier must have the following experience in order to be considered for award of the Contract. The contractor may utilize the same projects from Section A to accommodate the requirements of Section B if applicable:

- a. The Supplier must have completed a minimum of three (3) projects in Canada within the last ten (10) years working on municipal recreational facilities, including some of the following works: structural, envelope upgrades, architectural and accessibility, HVAC, plumbing and electrical installation. Each project to have a minimum value of \$4,000,000.00 Canadian dollars (excluding taxes).
- b. The Supplier has to demonstrate that they substantially completed, in a calendar year, in the past three (3) years, a minimum value of \$10,000,000.00 Canadian dollars (excluding taxes) of accumulative work for municipal or government agencies with no more than five (5) projects.
- c. The assigned construction site superintendent(s) must have supervised a minimum of three (3) projects involving the construction of a new or state of good repair recreational facility within the last ten (10) years. Suppliers must provide resumes, one (1) page maximum, for each of the assigned construction superintendent(s). Suppliers must upload the resume(s) in ARIBA under 4.5 Form E Resumes. Failure to upload the resume(s) shall result in your bid being declared as non-compliant.

2. Project Experience / Comparable Projects

The Supplier must provide reference projects for the purpose of confirming the Supplier's experience and track record of success. The Supplier shall provide the requested references for clients who have obtained construction services similar to those required for the Project from the Supplier in the last **ten (10)** years. Failure to provide verifiable experience shall result in the bid being declared non-compliant.

3. Qualification Requirements

a. Current Certificate of Recognition (COR®) or equivalent OHS Certification

Each Supplier shall acquire and upload a copy of a valid Certificate of Recognition (COR®) or Equivalent OHS Certification in the legal name of the Supplier or in the case of a joint Bid, for, and in the name of, each member of the Joint Bid Team.
